Our Guidelines: Teens are impatient Use initial search box, not Advanced Search Teens like to keep things simple Teach only a few key strategies Teens want to be engaged Make the lesson interactive

The 10-Word Limit Of 1 2 3 4 5 Searchterm "search term" –searchterm site:edu + 5 more possible search terms • double quotations (" ") use to look for words in exactly the order in which you enter them "human rights" "affirmative action" • minus sign (-) use to exclude a word from your results vikings –minnesota • site:edu site:org site:gov use to limit your search to pages published by certain groups teens site:org teens site:org teens site:gov
